Student and Staff Opportunities – Breakout Session

Session Summary

The breakout session for Quality of Teaching and Learning was attended by 16 SEADOM Congress participants from 8 countries. The participants reviewed the current subcommittee themes and agreed to amend the themes as follows:

The subcommittee exists to:

1. facilitate and endorse multi-national and multi-institutional collaborations
2. provide a resource for the dissemination of opportunities and projects for both staff and students
3. provide a platform to document and celebrate previous collaborations and inspire new ideas for future collaborations

Subcommittee agreed to focus on the SEADOM 2016 conference, working in consultation with Ex-Co and the host institution to propose a joint student performance and platform for these students alongside the congress, and enhance the participation from SEADOM student musicians for next year's congress.

Additionally, the Subcommittee will explore the creation of a forum service for members to assist in the dissemination of information amongst member institutions.
